This application process is structured so that you will gain insights into yourself as a person, so be prepared to open up and show the person that you truly are, or what you aspire to be. Dig deep, answer the questions, and complete the service project with the intent of learning something new. Do not fill out this application unless you are willing to full commit and participate in the leadership training process.

This year, we will be choosing quality students that we feel will positively benefit the music program, and we will adjust the leadership positions to fit the strengths of those students. Most positions will remain the same (i.e. drum major, guard captain, drum captain, wind captains); however, we may be adding additional roles.
